#### Course Description

Students learn to narrate using past time markers, to point out tasks and obligations, to expand on their ability to understand and express opinions on everyday activities. German II provides a rich context for learning vocabulary and expressing opinions. There are projects due that illustrate increasing proficiency. Student writing & reading assignments as well as matching assessments are done independently and outside of class required. Students must use a camera and have

#### Course Description

German III and IV reviews and expands on German grammar and explores general concepts. The primary objective of the course is to explore language as it is embedded in the culture using assignments done by exam or project work. Students complete writing assignments via Google Classroom. There is a mid-term (jar) work independently and outside of class required. Student request, and/or recommendation by the guidance counselor and faculty member.
