Course Description

Students learn to narrate using past time markers, to point out tasks and obligations, to expand on their ability to understand and express opinions on everyday activities. German II covers material presented in the textbook Netzwerk neu A1. 2 Kapitel 7-12. In addition, the course provides a rich context for learning vocabulary and expressing opinions. Assessment is done in increments explained as it is used in context. Assessment is done in increments. There are projects due that illustrate increasing proficiency.
