We are excited to be celebrating the 30th Annual Champion Games on **Friday**, **May 10th** at the Boscobel High School track! PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH ALL SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS WITHIN YOUR DISTRICT. The rain date is set for Monday, May 13th. Attending Champion Games will give your students a unique opportunity to compete in track events, various field events, wheelchair races, and other fun activities*. We would also encourage schools to bring along a non-special education friend for each student to incorporate an inclusive setting. However, this is not mandatory.

The Games will begin around 9:30 a.m. and will end after the relay races at approximately 1:00 p.m. There is no cost to attend and a free morning snack (Capri Sun juice and Rice Krispie treat). Lunch will not be provided - please plan accordingly. Each school is responsible for transportation and appropriate chaperones throughout this event.

Each school attending Champion Games **MUST** submit attendance numbers by Friday, April 26th. It is crucial that we receive an accurate number of students and chaperones attending in order to have enough snacks and awards. **See the next page for registration instructions**.

CANCELLATIONS/POSTPONEMENTS:

TRANSPORTATION/PARKING:

- All buses should park in the lot adjacent to the Boscobel City Park.
- No buses will be allowed to unload or park at the high school.

REGISTRATION/OPENING CEREMONY:

- Each school will receive a packet of information at the registration booth.
- Please turn in your relay sign-up form when you register.
- Opening Ceremonies will start at <u>9:30 sharp</u>, please try to have everyone seated in the bleachers at this time.

SNACK/LUNCH:

- A snack (Rice Krispie bar and Capri Sun juice) will be available midmorning for the students, chaperones, and bus drivers.
- "S" stickers will be provided in your registration packet to be redeemed for the snack.
- Please remind students to dispose of all trash in the appropriate containers.
- Lunch will <u>not</u> be provided. It is up to each school to bring additional snacks and water if they feel a need to do so.

MEDALS for all Champion Games participants will be distributed at the snack table at the completion of the relays. Please stop by to get them earlier, if you are leaving before the relay races. Medals should be given to participants upon completion of the day.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Encourage your students to dress appropriately for the weather (i.e., sunscreen, hats, jackets, etc.).
- Please use the outdoor bathroom facilities unless you have a student that needs a changing room, which is located in the school.
- If you need to use the changing room, please ask for assistance at the snack table.

CESA 3 Champion Games Relay Race Information

- 1. To conclude the day's events, we will be running relay races. Each school district will be limited to organizing a maximum of two (2) relay teams; <u>must have eight (8) team members on each team.</u>
- 2. On your way to Boscobel, or earlier, complete the relay sign-up sheet with the names of the students and/or chaperones running. **Relay sign-up sheets** <u>must</u> be handed in at check in. No late teams will be accepted!! Turn in the form when you check in on May 10th. Those people listed will be the ones who will run in this event.
- 3. Listen for the announcement for relay teams to come to the center of the track. Look for your school's sign and get your teams lined up and seated. You must have chaperones accompany teams and assist with getting runners to appropriate lanes.
- 4. All other students not running in the relays should be in the stands watching. It will be important to keep the track clear at all times for safety.
- 5. Eight relay teams will run at one time. Each of the 8 runners on each of the 8 teams will be spread out around the track by a colored flag. Each team will run a combined distance of 400m (1 time around the track). Each runner on a team will run about 50m (not long) and pass the baton to the next runner. We encourage wheelchair students to participate as well. Have another student or chaperone push them. After completing your relay, please return to your school section outside of the track.
